

## **Data Collection Worksheet**

**Please Note:** The Data Collection Worksheet (DCW) is a tool to aid integration of a PhenX protocol into a study. The PhenX DCW is not designed to be a data collection instrument. Investigators will need to decide the best way to collect data for the PhenX protocol in their study. Variables captured in the DCW, along with variable names and unique PhenX variable identifiers, are included in the PhenX Data Dictionary (DD) files.

1. Please tell me the names of the people who usually live in this household. Let's start with the person or one of the persons who owns or rents this home.

LIST ON ROWS A-J BELOW. IF HOME IS IN MORE THAN ONE PERSON'S NAME, LIST ANY OF THESE ON ROW A.

2. (Does/Do) (PERSON IN ROW A/you) have a spouse or unmarried partner who lives in the household?

LIST ON LINE B. IF THERE IS NO SPOUSE OR PARTNER, WRITE "NONE" IN ROW B.

3. Now, who else lives here?

LIST ADDITIONAL PERSONS ON ROWS C-J BELOW.

4. Have we forgotten anyone: such as babies or small children; roomers; people who usually live here, but are away temporarily-on business trips, at school, temporarily in a hospital, and so on?
