

Data Collection Worksheet

Please Note: The Data Collection Worksheet (DCW) is a tool to aid investigators to integrate the collection of PhenX measures in your study. The PhenX measures that you selected and added to your Cart are presented in the DCW in alphabetical order. The DCW includes worksheets for data collection. Variables derived from the collected data are shown in the Data Dictionary (DD) with variable names and unique PhenX variable identifiers. The collection of DCWs produced by the Toolkit is not designed as a data collection instrument. Each investigator will decide how to integrate PhenX measures into data collection for their study.

Summary of the Movement Disorders Society United Parkinson's Disease Rating Scale (MDS-UPDRS)

The Movement Disorder Society United Parkinson's Disease Rating Scale (MDS-UPDRS) is an examiner-administered test that includes four subscales: non-motor experiences of daily living (13 items), motor experiences of daily living (13 items), motor examination (33 scores based on 18 items, several with right, left or other body distribution scores), and motor complications (6 items). Each item is scored on a five point scale: 0 = normal; 1 = slight; 2 = mild; 3 = moderate; and 4 = severe. All items are summed together to give a total score, with higher scores indicating greater disability.

The Movement Disorder Society United Parkinson's Disease Rating Scale (MDS-UPDRS) is a proprietary instrument and administration (with the exception of personal use) requires a license from the [International Parkinson Movement Disorder Society](https://www.internationalparkinsonmovementdisordersociety.org/).
